FOUR PILLARS OF AWARENESS:

(I) Education

We work to support parishes with understanding and learning about the true history of Canada. Through speaking engagements and the KAIROS Blanket Exercise, we walk in a good way towards Truth and Reconciliation:

(2) Advocacy

We work to support clean and accessible water for all people in Canada through letter campaigns and events to raise awareness about current Indigenous issues across Canada;

(3) Spiritual Walk

We support the integration of thoughtful prayers and Indigenous-focused worship services;

(4) Strategic Funding

We assist the First Peoples of Canada through participation in the Advent Conspiracy program each December. Our specific work for 2015 will continue with the Pikangikum Water Project through PWRDF.
