

PARTNERSHIP POLICY

PURPOSE

To promote, emphasise and support partnership as both the work of and the way of working for PWRDF.

APPLICATION

This policy applies to all directors, members, employees and agents of PWRDF.

POLICY

- PWRDF works with the Anglican Church of Canada and its constituents
- PWRDF works with partners internationally and in Canada to achieve common goals
- While not compromising our Guiding Principles, PWRDF will respect all partners'
 - identities, beliefs and values
 - knowledge, experience and expertise
 - culture, ethnicity and diversity of religion
 - intellectual property rights
- All partners, irrespective of country, region or community will be afforded the norms of inclusiveness regardless of colour, gender, age, sexual orientation, religion, disability, or economic/social condition in accordance with the policies of PWRDF
- Communication will be conducted in a manner which is respectful, collegial, collaborative, open, and sensitive to local social norms
- All work will be conducted within the policies of PWRDF and its strategic plan

DEFINITION

For the purpose of this policy the definitions are as follows

Partnership is a relationship in which each partner has equal status, common interest and a certain independence, and also implicit and formal obligations to the other.
