An Opportunity to Multiply Donations and Feed the Hungry

Anglican Grow Hope maximizes your donations through the Primate's World Relief and Development Fund membership in the Canadian Foodgrains Bank. Matching federal funds can multiply donations three or four times, helping your donation go farther to feed the hungry.

Our Farm Family >>>

Chris, Leianne, and Jonathan Lea are our generous farming family that will be growing the crop for the Anglican Grow Hope project in Manitoba. They have donated fifteen acres of their farmland to Grow Hope.

When you sponsor one of fifteen acres of the Grow Hope project, the proceeds help end hunger. The organizing committee is hoping for enough donations to cover the cost of planting and harvesting 15 acres. The cost to raise an acre of wheat is approximately \$300.

When the wheat is sold, the Lea family is expecting to sell the

crop for anywhere from \$400 to \$450 per acre. The Lea family is not only donating the farmland, they are donating their time, equipment, and talent to plant, raise, and harvest the crop.
