

Voices OF HOPE

Thai-Burmese border

When the Myanmar military launched air raids near the eastern border of Myanmar's Karen State in March 2021, as many as 10,000 people fled their villages, hiding in the jungle and forests near the border. Three thousand people crossed the Salween River into Thailand close to Mae Sariang, where the office of long-time PWRDF partner DARE Network is located.

PWRDF issued an emergency solidarity grant of \$5,000 for Internally Displaced Peoples (IDPs) and DARE implemented the project, aiding those who had fled, leaving everything behind. The funds benefited 75 families with 364 members immediately by providing supplies for one month.

Saw Meh a grandfather from Ta Kaw Hta village who has had to move three times to find safety sent this message through DARE. "Thank you to all helper and donors for all of your kindness and lending your hand when they face with the difficulty and less of foods with hungry times."
